Online Risks to Children

- Exposure to Inappropriate Material
- Nudity or other sexually explicit material
- Gambling and other unsuitable behavior

- Cyber-bulling
- Physical Harm
- Sexual exploitation or enticement

 Hate group or racist web sites
 Promotional material about tobacco, alcohol, or drugs
 Intrusion to Privacy

Online Risks for Children:

Content

inappropriate material, access to 'pirated' material, disturbing content, malicious software

Contact

harassment, forming relationships with adults who have sexual or other abusive intentions

Commerce theft of identity, online fraud



3 Target Groups:

- Parents Action: Inform the parents
- Teachers

Action: Educate and support the teachers (support the teachers and provide parents with information

 - Action: Excite the kids!
 - ✓ Create awareness about how to securely use the Internet
 - ✓ Make them (and help them) become responsible Internet users



What is the message we need to pass to the kids:

• Be clever

- Don't believe everything you read
- Recognize when someone tries to set you up

Protect your PC

- Secure your PC
- Keep your passwords secret

• Be careful

- ✓ Be careful about what you tell whom over the Internet
- ✓ Pull the emergency break if necessary
